Second Collection this weekend **Apostleship of the Sea**

Seafarers and fishers play a vital role in all of our lives but they often work in difficult, hazardous conditions. Every year churches around the world celebrate Sea Sunday. It is a day for people to come together to pray for seafarers and fishers, and thank them for the vital role they play in all of our lives. Stella Maris chaplains and volunteers are working in ports up and down this country and across the world: but they cannot do it without your support.

A reflection from Pope Francis for the Year of Prayer, for the Fifteenth Sunday of the Year: The prayer of praise! Matthew's Gospel tells us that Jesus, in facing hostility and rejection, responds by praising God. He thanks the Father for who he is and for his love in revealing himself "to mere children" (Matthew 11:25), to the poor and humble of our world. Jesus' example of praise calls us to respond as he did at times when we feel God is absent or evil seems victorious. In praising God for everything, even "Sister Death", Saint Francis teaches us the importance, in all the circumstances of our lives, of praising God who is always faithful.
